Definition of Tech. Svcs.

- •Importance of inter-institution commonality - reduce glitches in moving between ships
- •Importance of clear understandings and undertakings early in planning
- Widening gap between expectations and what can be done (whose nickel)

Definition of Tech. Svcs., Cont'd.

- •Proper boundaries between tech groups and research groups - gear and people (especially 24 hour ops.)
- In-port changeovers and people power
- Limits to pressure on techs
