Antarctic Impacts

"At the extreme, failure of the Antarctic logistical support mission could result in closure of two of the three US Antarctic science stations (McMurdo and South Pole stations)."

"At the very least, logistic support of the stations would have to change in drastic, and likely undesirable ways."
