
UNOLS Year in Review: *Fleet Operations in 2017*

UNOLS Year in Review: *Fleet Modernization Efforts*

- Mid-Life Refit of Global Ships:
 - R/V Thompson mid-life is almost complete and sea trials are underway
 - Mid-life refit plans for R/Vs Revelle and Atlantis are underway
- Regional Class Research Vessels:
 - Construction stage started in July 2017.
 - OSU Contract with Gulf Island Shipyards for one ship (two more ships as options)




 Over 3,000 visitors and over 500 people toured R/V Endeavor.


