

NOAA Ships – Days at Sea




NOAA Fleet Highlights FY17


- Achieved 85% DAS execution rate despite high loss of DAS due to weather
- Post Project Survey roll-out
- Positive Work Environment Video in Development
- Successful completion of CAPSTONE project
- Hydrographic survey work in Arctic
- Hurricane Maria response work in Puerto Rico and US Virgin Islands

NOAA Fleet Challenges FY17

- Unplanned major repair period
- Aging fleet, increased maintenance costs
- Balancing maintenance and mission schedule requirements
- VSAT and mission systems reliability
