The Problem

Principle Investigators/Chief Scientists (PI/CS) often request additional resources—such as in-port time, equipment, and personnel—after the cruise schedule has already been finalized.

These late-stage requests place significant pressure on schedulers, cruise planners, operators, and supporting agencies, requiring reallocation of resources and scheduling adjustments, which can be both **costly and time-consuming.**



Contributing Factors

- Uncertainty of available Resources
- Changes in Plans
- Underestimating Mobilization and Demobilization
- Late Schedule Release
- Limited Resources for early cruise planning



Goal

A solution that will

- Find major resource challenges early in the process, BEFORE scheduling
- Limited additional effort/resources to the Cruise Planning Process
- Be worthwhile
- Get buy-in from stakeholders



Two-phased approach

PHASE 1: Project Support Review


• Preliminary review of the project. The Ship Operator, any requested facilities (e.g. NDSF, Pools, MarSSAM), and the PI/CS will update the SME as required and "sign off" that this is their level of support prior to scheduling.

PHASE 2: Project Support Plan

 Later review of all Cruise Planning process. The Ship Operator, any requested facilities (e.g. NDSF, Pools, MarSSAM), and the PI/CS will be required to "sign off" on the plan that this is their level of support.

Hurdles / Comments / Concerns

- •Timing: Will the proposed timeline work?
- •Resources: Do the institutions have enough people and time to complete both PHASE 1&2?
- •Culture Shift:
 - For PI/CSs. There is concern this will just be one more thing to "nag" the PI/CS about.
 - Our operators are ingrained in helping to the nth degree even if it breaks them
- •Teeth?: What happens if the PI/CS do not complete the Cruise Planning info on time?
